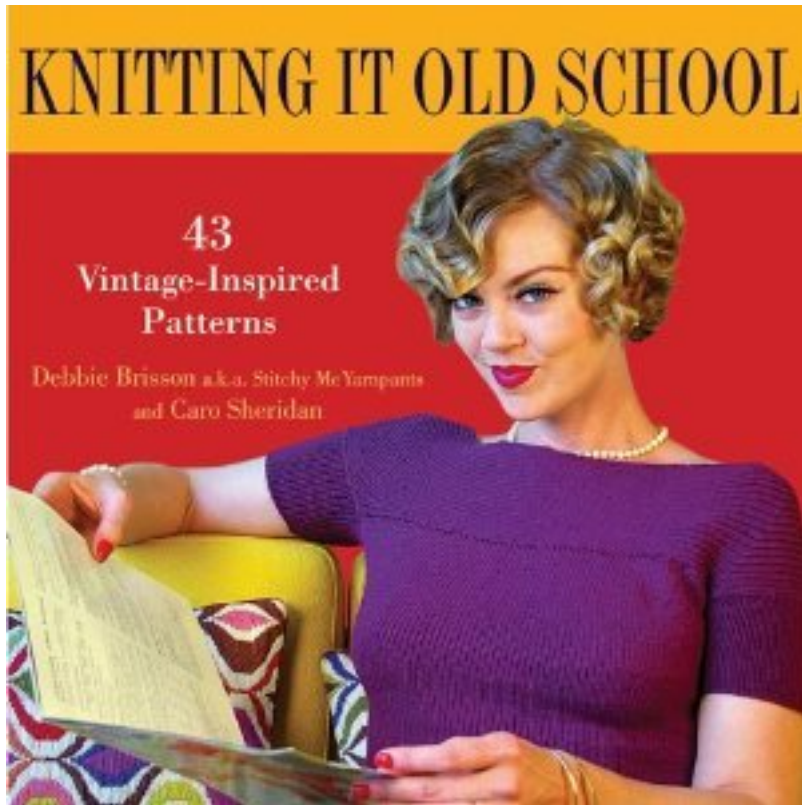


The fall book harvest is abundant this year with great new titles from many talents featured in Twist Collective, and that we're proud to recommend.
