?22 sts and 22 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over chart pattern using larger needles, after blocking

21 ½ sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in single color Stockinette stitch in the round using smaller needles, after blocking

**Construction Notes:** Open front cardigan worked in Fair Isle-style stranded colorwork. The body is worked from the bottom up in the round with steeks at center front and armholes. Sleeves and collar are worked from stitches picked up along the cut edges of the steeks.

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
