Bust: $34 \frac{3}{4} (39 \frac{1}{4}, 42 \frac{1}{4}, 46 \frac{3}{4}, 50, 54 \frac{1}{4}, 57 \frac{3}{4})$ " / 88.5 (99.5, 107.5, 118.5, 127, 138, 146.5) cm Length: $24 \frac{1}{2} (25 \frac{1}{2}, 25 \frac{1}{2}, 25 \frac{1}{2}, 26 \frac{1}{2}, 26 \frac{1}{2})$ " / 62 (65, 65, 65, 67.5, 67.5, 67.5) cm Shown in size $38 \frac{1}{4}$ " / 97 cm Intended to be worn with 2-5" / 2.5-5 cm ease.

Yarn:

5 (6, 7, 8, 8, 9, 10) skeins Imperial Yarn Columbia (220 yd / 201 m per 4 oz / 113 g skein; 100% Wool) in #114 Dusty Rose

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long Size 8 US / 5 mm:

- circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long
- circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long
- needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Five stitch markers, cable needle, tapestry needle, six buttons 1" / 2.5 cm diameter, four stitch holders

Gauge:

18 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitches using size 8 US / 5 mm needles

Construction Notes: This cardigan is worked in one piece from the bottom up, with the sleeves worked in the round joined before working the yoke. Inset pockets are worked along with the body. Cable patterns are given in chart form only.
