



Play the coquette in a stylish, slouchy tee worked from the center panel out.

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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 38 (42, 46, 50, 54, 58)" / 96.5 (106.5, 117, 127, 137, 147.5) cm

Shown in size 42" / 106.5 cm

Intended to fit with 8" / 20.5 cm positive ease.

**Yarn:**

5 (5, 6, 6, 7, 7) skeins Manos del Uruguay Serena (170 yd / 155 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 60% Baby Alpaca, 40% Pima Cotton) in #2672 Lilac

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm long

Two stitch markers, blocking supplies

**Gauge:**

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette Stitch using larger needle

24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Chinese Lace pattern using larger needle, after blocking

**Construction Notes:** This easy fitting pullover begins with the lace panels at center front and back. Stitches are picked up along the sides of these panels and cast on for the sides of the neck, then the sweater is worked outward to the side seams and sleeves. The shaped hemline is longer in the back. The lace pattern is given in both chart form and row-by-row instructions.

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
