



This classic cabled pullover features a shaped waist, set-in sleeves and a turtleneck. The body is worked in the round to the armholes, then divided for front and back. The sleeves are worked separately in the round, then sewn in place. The cable patterns are given in chart form only.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 35 (37, 39, 42 $\frac{3}{4}$, 45 $\frac{1}{4}$, 48, 50 $\frac{1}{2}$, 53 $\frac{1}{2}$)" / 89 (94, 99, 108.5, 115, 122, 128.5, 136) cm

Length: 24 (24 $\frac{1}{2}$, 25, 25 $\frac{1}{2}$, 26 $\frac{1}{2}$, 27, 28, 28 $\frac{1}{2}$)" / 61 (62, 63.5, 65, 67.5, 68.5, 71, 72.5) cm

Shown in size 35" / 92.5 cm

Intended to be worn with -1 to 1" / -2.5 to 2.5 cm ease.

Yarn:

11 (12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19) balls Schoeller+Stahl Limbo (136 yd / 125 m per 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz / 50 g ball; 100% Virgin Wool Superwash) in #4510 Natural

Needles & Notions:

Size 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 3 mm circular needles, 32" / 80 cm long

Size 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 3 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needles, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needles, 16" / 40 cm long

Cable needle, stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn or stitch holder

Gauge:

22 sts and 37 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using smaller needles

27 sts and 37 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Body Chart using smaller needles, after blocking

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
