



This cardigan is worked seamlessly from the top down, with saddle shoulders, a deep V-neck and waist shaping. The generous shawl collar is worked from stitches picked up around the neck edge. The intricate cable patterns are presented in chart form only.

Bust 32 (36, 39 ¼, 43 ¼, 47 ¾, 50 ¼, 54 ¾)" / 81.5 (91.5, 99.5, 110, 121.5, 127.5, 139) cm Length: 13 ½ (13 ½, 14, 15, 15, 16, 16)" / 34 (34, 35.5, 38, 38, 40.5, 40.5) cm

Intended to be worn with 3–4" / 7.5–10 cm positive ease.

Yarn:

10 (10, 12, 13, 15, 16, 16) skeins Brooklyn Tweed Shelter (140 yd /128 m per 50 g skein; 100% Targhee-Columbia Wool) in #17 Embers

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 6 US / 4.0 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Stitch markers, cable needle, waste yarn or stitch holder, removable stitch markers or scrap yarn, five buttons 1 1/8" / 30 mm diameter

Gauge:

20 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles

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
