This hat and mitten set features a picot edge, a Latvian Braid border and an unusual knot stitch incorporated into the stranded colorwork. The hat is knit from the bottom up. The mittens begin with the cuff. The colorwork patterns are given in chart form only.

Hat:

Head circumference: 20 ¼ (21 ¾, 23 ¼)" / 51.5 (55, 59) cm

Height: 5 (5 ¼, 5 ½)" / 12.5 (13.5, 14) cm

Shown in size 21 ¾" / 55 cm

Mittens:

Hand circumference: 7 (7 ¾, 8 ¼)" / 18 (19.5, 21) cm

Length: 9 ¾ (10 ½, 11 ¼)" / 25 (26.5, 28.5) cm

Shown in size 7 ¾" / 19.5 cm

Yarn:

elann.com Peruvian Highland Wool (109 yd / 100 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 100% Highland Wool):

3 (3, 4) balls in #2762 Ink (MC)

1 (1, 2) ball(s) in # 2699 Starlight Blue (CC1)

1 ball #1255 Irish Moss (CC2)

Yarn quantities listed will make the set. For just the hat or just the mittens, you'll need 2 (2, 3) balls of MC, 1 of CC1, and 1 of CC2.

Needles & Notions:

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 6 US / 4 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Ring marker, locking stitch marker, waste yarn, tapestry needle

Gauge:

Hat: 22 sts and 28 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over charted colorwork pattern using largest needles

Mittens: 24 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over charted colorwork pattern using largest needles
