



These mittens begin at the cuff, which is worked flat in rows. Then they are joined to work in the round through the hand with a gusset thumb. The colorwork pattern is presented in chart form only.

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**Finished measurements:**

Hand circumference: 6  $\frac{3}{4}$  (7  $\frac{3}{4}$ )" / 17 (19.5) cm

**Yarn:**

Sun Valley Fibers Yarn MCN - Fingering (400 yd / 366 m per 3  $\frac{1}{2}$  oz / 100 g skein; 80% Merino, 10% Cashmere, 10% Nylon):

1 skein in Coral (MC)

1 skein in Geranium (CC)

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 6  $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 17 cm: Size 1 US / 2.25 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 7  $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 19.5 cm: Size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Stitch markers, small amount smooth waste yarn, tapestry needle

**Gauge:**

Size 6  $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 17 cm: 35 sts and 40 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over Chart using Size 1 US / 2.25 mm needles

Size 7  $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 19.5 cm: 31 sts and 35 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over Chart using Size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles

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
