

A fleece-lined sweater for son or daughter with very fine vertical stripes, made especially for with handpainted or variegated yarn.

57-68 US

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Construction Notes: Knit flat. Vertical stripe pattern is created by slipping stitches, so that the knitter is only working with one color at a time.

Finished measurements: Chest 22 (24, 26, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36) / 56 (61, 66, 71, 76, 81.5, 86.5, 91.5) cm. Back Length 12 (13, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, 22) / 30.5 (33, 35.5, 38, 40.5, 45.5, 51, 56) cm. Sleeve Seam 6 % 7 % 8 % 10 % 11 % 13 % 14 % 15 1/2 / 16.5 (19, 21.5, 24.5, 26, 34.5, 37, 39.5) cm

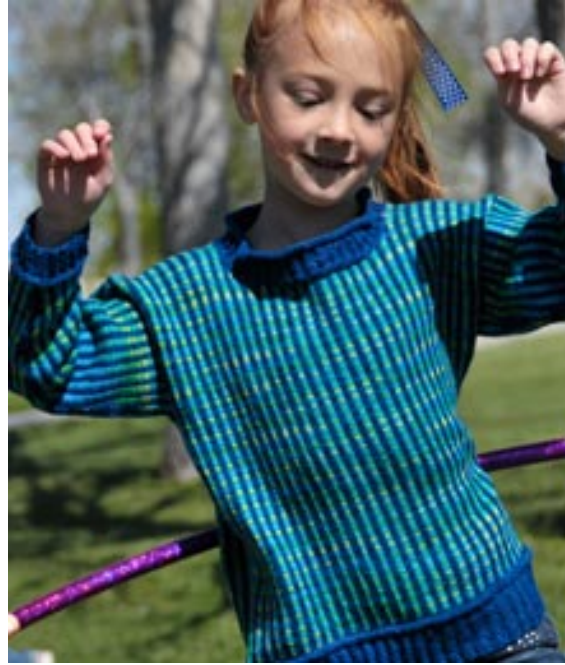

Yarn: ShibuiKits Sock Fingering Weight (95% poly / 5% silk / 175 m per 1 1/2 oz / 50 g, 100% Superwash Merino Wool)

3 (D, 4, 4, 5, 5, 6, 7) skeins in 52055 Montage (MC)

2 (D, 3, 3, 3, 4, 5, 6) skeins in 53660 Arroyo (CC)

Needles & Notions: Size 3 US / 3.25 mm needles, size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles, four removable stitch markers



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Gauge: 32 sts and 37 rows to 4" / 10 cm over stitch pattern using larger needles; 28 sts and 40 rows to 4" / 10 cm over 2x at using larger needles
