

Recommended for the adventurous intermediate to advanced knitter, the pattern features row by row shaping instructions.

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Construction Notes: Worked both in the round and back-and-forth. Bodies are knit from top to head using short rows to shape the belly and head, and bodies made along back of tail and body. Eyes, arms and legs made separately, then attached. Pieces are stuffed as you go. Cardigan bodies are worked from pieces with stitches placed on hold for armholes, and then joined together at top. Sleeves are picked up at the armholes and worked down. Bodies knit clockwise.

Finished measurements: Finished size: 11" (28 cm)

Yarn: Cascade Yarns Cascade 220 Wool (220 yds / 201 m per 3 1/2 oz / 100 g skein; 100% Peruvian Highland wool).

Wool (Blue crocodile): 1 skein in 8002 Primavera (G) and 1 skein in 8005 Robin Egg Blue (B).

Wool (Green crocodile): 1 skein in 8003 Primavera (G) and 1 skein in 7802 Cactus (P).

Needles & Notions: Size 2 US (2.75 mm) set of double pointed needles and pair of straight needles; cable needle; tapestry needle; three stitch holders; stuffing; black embroidery floss; two 17/2 cm buttons for each cardigan (samples used custom buttons made by Mending Stone Company; purchased at myspace.com); two 18/1.5 cm yellow buttons for eyes of each crocodile.

Gauge: 20 sts and 40 rows = 4" / 10 cm over Stockinette stitch (unofficial). This toy is knitted at a tight gauge to keep its stuffing from showing.
