

A typical stitch pattern for a raglan sweater. Please note, stitch pattern is given in charted form and is not by row instructions.

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Finished chest measurements: 41 1/2 (44, 47 1/2, 51 1/2, 54 1/2) / 105 (112, 120, 131 1/2, 138) cm, intended to fit with about 2" / 5 cm of ease. Shown in size 41 1/2" / 105 cm.

Yarn: 13 (15, 16, 18, 20) Skeins Valley Yarns Arnhem (100 yds) / 100 m per 1.7 oz / 50 g ball, 100% Merino Wool in Soft Brown.

Needles & Notions: Size 9 US (4.5 mm circular needle, 32" / 100 cm long. Size 9 US (4.5 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles. Size 7 US (4.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long. Adjust needle size if necessary to obtain correct gauge. Long stitch holder, spare circular needle or long yarn stitch markers, yarn needle.

Gauge: 21 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Cable cast using larger needles. To save time and to ensure accurate sizing, check gauge.

Construction Notes: Body is knit in the round to the underarms. Saddle shoulder elements are knit separately then sewn in place. Cable pattern is given both in charts and row-by-row instructions.
