

A light and airy cardigan worked seamlessly in a breezy-catching gauge, to be worn in multiple ways to suit all your best features.

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Finished bust measurements: 30 (31), 36 1/2, 38, 42, 45 1/2, 48 1/2, 51, 54, 57 1/2, 60 1/2, 63 1/2, 70 (80), 82 1/2, 90, 100 1/2, 110 1/2, 123, 129 1/2, 137, 146, 153 1/2, 160 cm. Shown in size 38" / 96 cm. Intended to fit with about 2" of ease.

Yarn: 4 (4, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 7, 7) skeins Coosawadee Kibbe Hand-Quilt 80%, 402 yds / 289 m per 4 oz / 115 g skein; 100% Blue Faced Leicester (Wool) in Lilac.

Needles & Notions: Size 6 US / 4 mm circular needles, 24" / 60 cm long; Size 6 US / 4 mm set of double-pointed needles or a second circular for 2-cm method; Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular hook or a hook one size larger than needle size necessary to obtain gauge in knitting (reference the mm number to compare knitting to crocheted gauge). Four stitch markers, stitch holders or scrap yarn; tapestry needle.

Gauge: 16 sts and 26 1/2 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch. To save time and to ensure accurate sizing, check gauge.

Construction Notes: Knit in one piece. Sleeves are worked from stitches picked up around the armholes. Crochet lettuce edging.



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
