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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 29<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> (33<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 37<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 41, 44<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 48<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>, 52<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, 56)" / 75.5 (85, 94.5, 104, 113.5, 123, 132.5, 142) cm  
Intended to fit with about 2" / 5 cm of ease. Shown in size 37<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" / 94.5 cm.

**Yarn:** Classic Elite Yarns Kumara (128 yards / 117 m per 1<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> oz / 50 g ball; 85% Extra Fine Merino, 15% Baby Camel)

7 (8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14) balls in #5721 Grasshopper  
1 ball in #5709 Wild Duck

**Needles & Notions:** Size 8 US / 5 mm circular needle, 29" / 74 cm long

Size 8 US / 5 mm set of 4 or 5 double pointed needles

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 29" / 74 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm set of 4 or 5 double-pointed needles

Size H US / 5 mm crochet hook, small amount of smooth waste yarn, five stitch markers, six 7/8" / 22 mm buttons

**Gauge:** 17 sts and 19 rows = 4" / 10 cm in St st with larger needles; 17 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Garter stitch with smaller needles

**Construction Notes:** Worked in the round from the bottom up; the sleeves are worked separately and joined at armhole level, then the yoke is worked in the round to the neck. The yoke is set off by a band of bobble-embellished colorwork, which is given in chart form only. The slit neck opening is accented with button and loop closures. The <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> length sleeves are slightly gathered at the cuff.

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
