Bottom-up hat knitting is familiar and comfortable for many knitters, but working top-down gives the ability to easily adjust the final length.

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Finished measurements:

Circumference at brim: 18 (20)" / 45.5 (51) cm

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm negative ease.

Yarn: Caledon Hills Worsted Wool (220 yds / 200 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Wool)

Short Row version shown in smaller size and worked top-down: 1 skein in #933 Moose (MC) and 1 skein in #865 Sweet Pea (CC)

Straight version in shown in larger size and worked bottom-up: 1 skein in #943 Slate (MC) and 1 skein in #913 Icy Pond (CC)

Needles & Notions: Size 8 US / 5 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 8 US / 5 mm set of 5 double-pointed needles

Tapestry needle, 8 stitch markers

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

Construction Notes: Worked bottom-up OR top-down, with or without short rows

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
