



This beret is worked in two layers with two different yarns – a sport weight yarn for the Stockinette st inner layer, and a lace weight yarn for the delicate lace overlay.

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Finished measurements:

Band circumference, unstretched: 19" / 48.5 cm

Diameter: 11" / 28 cm after blocking

Yarn:

Blue version:

1 skein Zitron Filigran (656 yds / 600 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Merino Superwash Wool) in #2515 Navy (MC)

2 skeins Schulana Angora Fashion (122 yds / 112 m per ¾ oz / 25 g ball; 80% Angora, 20% Nylon) in #34 Ice Blue (CC)

Mauve version:

1 skein Zitron Filigran (656 yds / 600 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Merino Superwash Wool) in #2519 Orchid (MC)

2 skeins Austermann Merino Silk (126 yds / 115 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 70% Merino Superfine Wool, 22% Silk, 8% Cashmere) in #616 Purple (CC)

Needles & Notions:

Size 2 ½ US / 3 mm circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm:

- circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long.
- set of five double pointed needles

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm:

- circular needle, 16" / 40 cm long.
- set of five double pointed needles

Tapestry needle, 11" / 28 cm diameter dinner plate or circular plastic blocking form

Gauge: 24 sts and 36 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in k1, p1 ribbing using MC held doubled and size 2 ½ US / 3 mm needle

24 sts and 36 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using CC and size 4 US / 3.5 mm needle

24 sts and 32 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using MC and size 5 US / 3.75 mm needle

Construction Notes: The hat is worked in the round with double pointed and circular needles. It begins with the ribbed band worked with the lighter weight yarn doubled. The main body of the hat is worked in Stockinette st with the heavier yarn. Stitches are then picked up along the top of the ribbing and the lighter weight yarn is used to knit the lace portion of the hat. The lace pattern is presented in row-by-row instructions only; no charts. Blocking the hat gently fuses the layers together.

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
