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Twists and turns and clever short rows turn these hats on their side for an unexpected construction that will keep your interest while you knit and catch your eye when you are done.

**Yarn:** 2 balls Valley Yarns Amherst (109 yds / 100 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g ball; 100% Merino Wool) in Soft Brown, Regatta Blue or Olive

**Needles & Notions:**

Size 5 US / 3.5 mm needles

Several yards of waste yarn (preferably

the same weight as working yarn in smooth cotton in a contrasting color), two cable needles, tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 12 sts and 16 rows = 1 ?" / 3.5 cm wide and 2" / 5 cm high in large knotted cable pattern (see Chart B, black solid outline)

8 sts and 16 rows = 1 ½" / 4 cm wide and 2" / 5 cm high in double garter stitch (see Chart B, black dotted outline)

21 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in double garter stitch

**Construction Notes:** This hat relies on Japanese short rows and grafting (diagrams included).

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
