branch and bud motifs. The easy-to-work stitch patterns and wrong-side rest rows make this piece a great first shawl project, or a fun, relaxing weekend traveler for experienced knitters. Its ornate appearance belies the simplicity of its construction; this piece knits up quickly and effortlessly to make a beautiful spring accessory or last-minute gift.

18 (22, 28)" / 45.5 (56, 71) cm long at center back

42 (54, 68)" / 106.5 (137, 172.5) cm across top edge

### Yarn:

Green version (22" length): 2 (3, 3) skeins Kollage Yarns Creamy (200 yds / 182 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 80% Milk, 20% Cotton) in #7102 Canopy Green

Purple version (22" length): 1 (2, 2) skeins The Natural Dye Studio Precious 4-ply (437 yds / 400 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 100% Silk) in Heather

Pink version (18" length): 1 (2, 2) skeins The Natural Dye Studio Angel (393 yds / 359 m per 3 ½ oz / 100 g skein; 70% Alpaca, 20% Silk, 10% Cashmere) in Sugar

Blue version (18" length): 2 (3, 3) skeins Spirit Trail Fiberworks Neith (200 yds / 182 m per 2 oz / 55 g skein; 55% Bombyx Silk, 45% Cashmere) in Chalcedony

### Needles & Notions:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needle 24" / 60 cm long for hem

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm circular needle 24" / 60 cm long for body

Size 3 US / 3.25 mm double-pointed needle (optional), stitch markers, tapestry needle

**Gauge:** 24 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch on smaller needles before blocking

**Construction Notes:** This design is worked from lower edge to neck. Directions for the stitch patterns are given in both charts and row-by-row instructions.

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
