



This V-neck cardigan has three-quarter length set-in sleeves and fronts that are slightly longer than the back. Lace panels border both front edges and are repeated on the upper back. An optional ribbed collar adds a delicate touch.

Yarn: 1100 (1200, 1500, 1800, 2100, 2400) yds / 1006 (1097, 1372, 1646, 1920, 2195) m Catherine Lowe Couture Yarns Custom Blend CL IV #5B (equivalent to Double Knitting [DK] weight; 59% Royal Baby Alpaca, 41% Silk) in Peacock (MC)

50 yds / 46 m Catherine Lowe Couture Yarns #1 (equivalent to fingering weight; 40% Silk, 60% Kid Mohair) in Peacock (CC) (Optional; used for collar only)

Catherine Lowe Couture Yarns are sold by yardage, not by weight or by the skein.

Needles & Notions:

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm circular needles, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm needles

Stitch markers, stitch holders, one large hook and eye

Gauge: 25 sts and 32 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using MC and larger needles; 34 ¼ sts = 4" / 10 cm in K2, p2 rib using CC and smaller needles

Construction Notes: This sweater is worked in pieces and sewn together, with k2, p2 ribbing on all edges. The lace pattern which borders the front edges and reappears at the upper back is presented in chart form only. The narrow front bands are worked in k2, p2 ribbing from stitches picked up along the edge. The optional collar is knit separately and sewn in place at the inside of the neck edge. The sweater is closed with a single hook and eye.

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
