



This simple striped cardigan has a draped front, raglan sleeves and subtle waist shaping.

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Finished measurements:

Bust: 29 ¼ (31 ½, 33 ¼, 36 ½, 42, 46, 50)" / 74.5 (80, 84.5, 92.5, 106.5, 117, 127) cm

Length: 20 ½ (21, 21½, 22, 22 ¼, 23, 23 ¼)" / 52 (53.5, 54.5, 56, 56.5, 58.5, 59) cm

Shown in size 31 ½" / 80 cm

Intended to fit with little or no ease. Note that the fronts of this cardigan overlap and drape for a relaxed fit. The finished bust measurement given is twice the measurement across the back just below the underarms. Choose the size just smaller than your actual bust measurement.

Yarn: Classic Elite Inca Alpaca (109 yds / 100 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Alpaca):

6 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) skeins in #1103 Amarino Grey (MC)

1 skein each in #1163 Morning Glory (CC1), #1135 Cala Cala Moss (CC2), #1146 Island of the Sun (CC3), and #1179 Santo Grape (CC4)

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm set of five double-pointed needles

Six stitch markers, tapestry needle, waste yarn

Gauge: 20 sts and 26 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

Construction Notes: The body of this cardigan is worked flat in one piece to the armholes, with shaping at the waist. The sleeves are worked to the armholes, and then joined to the body. The sweater continues in one piece to through the yoke to the neck. All edges feature narrow k1, p1 ribbing.

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
