



This raglan jacket is worked in simple Stockinette stitch with turned hems. The shawl collar provides textural interest with its all-over Star Stitch pattern.

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**Finished measurements:**

Bust: 31 (35, 39, 43, 47, 51)" / 78.5 (89, 99, 109, 119.5, 129.5) cm

Length: 22 ½ (22 ¾, 23 ¾, 24 ½, 25 ¼,

25 ½)" / 57 (58, 60.5, 62, 64, 65) cm

Shown in size 35" / 89 cm

Intended to be worn with 1–3" / 2.5–7.5 cm ease at bust.

**Yarn:** 10 (11, 13, 15, 17, 18) skeins O-Wool Classic Worsted (99 yds / 90 m per 1 ¾ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Certified Organic Merino Wool) in #6402 Saffron

**Needles & Notions:**

Two size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needles, 36" / 90 cm long

Two size 7 US / 4.5 mm double-pointed needles for edging (optional)

Stitch markers, stitch holders, scrap yarn, six safety pins, six buttons ¾" / 2 cm diameter

**Gauge:** 18 sts and 24 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch

**Construction Notes:** This jacket is worked in one piece from the neck down, with increase along the raglan lines to shape the yoke. The body has a slight flare from armholes to hem. Both body and sleeves feature turned hems. The shawl collar is knit separately from a chart or row-by-row instructions and sewn in place. The front and collar edges are finished with an applied i-cord.

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
