Bust: 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ (35, 37 $\frac{3}{4}$, 40 $\frac{3}{4}$, 42 $\frac{1}{4}$, 45, 48, 51, 53 $\frac{3}{4}$)" / 85 (89, 96, 103.5, 107.5, 114.5, 122, 129.5, 136.5) cm Length: 19 $\frac{1}{4}$ (19 $\frac{1}{4}$, 19 $\frac{1}{2}$, 19 $\frac{3}{4}$, 20, 20 $\frac{1}{4}$, 20 $\frac{3}{4}$, 21)" / 49 (49, 49.5, 50, 51, 51.5, 52, 52.5, 53.5) cm

Yarn: Green Mountain Spinnery Local Color (180 yds / 165 m per 2 oz / 57 g skein; 100% Certified Organic Fine Wool):

5 (6, 7, 7, 7, 8, 8, 9, 9) skeins in Fern (MC) 1 (2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2) skeins in Aster (CC)

Needles & Notions:

Size 5 US / 3.75 mm circular needle, 32" / 80 cm or longer, depending on size being made Size 5 US / 3.75 mm double-pointed needles or preferred needles for knitting small circumferences in the round

Stitch markers, stitch holders or waste yarn

Gauge: 22 sts and 32 rnds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over Chart pattern

Construction Notes: The body is knit in the round from the hem to the underarm. Three quarter length sleeves are worked in the round from the cuff to the underarm, then the body and sleeves are joined to work the yoke in the round. The neck is shaped with short rows. This sweater is worked in stranded colourwork. Carry the colour not in use loosely along the WS of the work.
