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Finished measurements:

Hand circumference: 6 ¼ (6 ¾, 7 ¼)" / 16 (17, 18.5) cm

Hand length: 6 ¾ (7 ¼, 8)" / 17 (18.5, 20.5) cm

Total length: 8 ¾ (9 ¼, 10)" / 22 (23.5, 25.5) cm

Shown in size 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 17 cm

Yarn:

Handwerks So-Soft-Sock (435 yds / 389 m per 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ oz / 100 g skein; 80% Superwash Merino, 10% Cashmere, 10% Nylon):

One skein in Night (MC)

One skein in Lavender (CC)

Needles & Notions:

Size 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 16 cm

- Size 1 US / 2.25 mm and size 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 2.5 mm double-pointed needles

Size 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 17 cm

- Size 1 US / 2.25 mm and size 2 US / 2.75 mm double-pointed needles

Size 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 18.5 cm

- Size 1 US / 2.25 mm and size 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 3 mm double-pointed needles

Stitch marker, tapestry needle

Gauge:

Size 6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 16 cm 34 sts and 38 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over chart pattern using size 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 2.5 mm needles

Size 6 $\frac{3}{4}$ " / 17 cm 32 sts and 36 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over chart pattern using size 2 US / 2.75 mm needles

Size 7 $\frac{1}{4}$ " / 18.5 cm 30 sts and 32 rounds = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch over chart pattern using size 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ US / 3 mm needles

Construction Notes: These mittens are worked from the ribbed cuff to the rounded tip. The stranded colorwork pattern is presented in chart form only.

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
