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Finished measurements:

Bust: 31 ¼ (33 ½, 36, 38 ½, 40 ¾, 43 ¼,

45 ½, 48, 52 ¾, 55 ¼, 57 ½)" / 79.5 (85, 91.5, 98, 103.5, 110, 115.5, 122, 134, 140.5, 146) cm

Length: 20 (20 ¼, 20 ¾, 21, 21, 21 ½, 21 ¾, 22, 22 ½, 22 ¾, 23 ¼)" / 51 (51.5, 52.5, 53.5, 53.5, 54.5, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59) cm

Shown in size 33 ½" / 85 cm

Intended to be worn no ease. Garments made of plant fiber have little elasticity and will tend to grow a bit with time. If you fall between sizes, you will probably find that the smaller size will fit better over time.

Yarn:

7 (7, 8, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 11, 12, 12) skeins Kollage Yarns Corntastic (105 yds / 96 m per 1 ½ oz / 50 g skein; 100% Corn) in #6505 Garnet

Needles & Notions:

Sizes 6 US / 4 mm:

- circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long
- needles in style preferred for small circumference knitting in the round

Size 4 US / 3.5 mm:

- circular needle, 24" / 60 cm long
- needles in style preferred for small circumference knitting in the round

Size E-4 US / 3.5 mm crochet hook

Size G-6 US / 4 mm crochet hook for crochet cast on (optional)

Tapestry needle, stitch markers, stitch holders

Gauge:

20 sts and 30 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch using size US 4 / 3.5 mm needles

18 ¾ sts = 4" / 10 cm in single crochet using size E-4 US / 3.5 mm crochet hook

Construction Notes: Square neck top worked in the round from the lace border up with waist shaping. Pattern includes tutorial for picot cast-on. Short sleeves also feature lace border. Lace pattern is presented in both Chart and row-by-row instructions. Neck edging is crocheted.

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
