Bust: 29 $\frac{3}{4}$ (33 $\frac{3}{4}$, 37 $\frac{3}{4}$, 41 $\frac{3}{4}$, 45 $\frac{3}{4}$, 49 $\frac{3}{4}$, 53 $\frac{3}{4}$, 57 $\frac{3}{4}$)" / 75.5 (85.5, 96, 106, 116, 126.5, 136.5, 146.5) cm

Length: 26 (26 $\frac{1}{4}$, 26 $\frac{1}{2}$, 27 $\frac{1}{4}$, 27 $\frac{1}{4}$, 27 $\frac{1}{2}$, 28, 28 $\frac{1}{4}$)" / 66 (66.5, 67.5, 69, 69, 70, 71, 72) cm

Intended to be worn with 0–2" / 0–5 cm negative ease.

Yarn:

7 (7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 12) skeins Valley Yarns Goshen (92 yds / 84 m per 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ oz / 50 g skein; 48% Cotton, 46% Rayon, 6% Silk) in #19 Mulberry

Needles & Notions:

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm circular needle, 24–40" / 60–100 cm long, depending on your size

Size 7 US / 4.5 mm needles in preferred style for small circumference knitting in the round

Two stitch holders, five stitch markers, safety pin, tapestry needle

Gauge:

18 sts and 23 rows = 4" / 10 cm in Stockinette stitch after blocking

Construction Notes: Scoop neck top worked without seams from the top down. The shoulders are shaped with short rows. The body features waist shaping, and flares for an easy fit around the hips. Collar and cap sleeves are worked from stitches picked up from the edges.

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
