Page 1 - A second Note has been added: "Large eyelets are made in the lace pattern by working 2 yarn overs next to each other. When you come to these yarn overs on the WS row, knit the first one and purl the second one."

Page 3 - On both charts, wherever there is an instance of 2 yarn overs (2 outlined circle symbols) next to each other on the odd-numbered rows, there is a corresponding k1, p1 (1 solid circle symbol, 1 blank symbol) on the following even-numbered row.

On Chart A, the following stitches are k1 (1 solid circle symbol):

Set-up row 2: 13, 22, 62, 71

Row 2: 21, 61, 70

Rows 4 and 16: 13, 22, 62, 71

Rows 6 and 14: 14, 23, 63, 72

Rows 8 and 12: 15, 24, 64, 73

Row 10: 16, 25, 65, 74

On Chart B, the following stitches are k1 (1 solid circle symbol):

Set-up row 2 and row 16: 87, 106

Row 2: 86, 105

Row 4: 87, 104

Row 6: 88, 103

Row 8: 89, 102

Row 10: 90, 103

Row 12: 89, 104

Row 14: 88, 105
